Clinical Commissioning Group

There are a range of healthcare services you and your family can access if you become unwell. This will help you to receive treatment fast, leaving emergency services to those who need them most. Below are a list of services available to you. Further details on each service can be found on the website above.

Self-care

Self-care is the best choice to treat very minor illnesses and injuries.

NHS 111

NHS 111 is a free new phone service, which is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. It offers a one-stop number for patients with urgent, but not life-threatening symptoms who want a fast and easy way to get help when they need it.

Pharmacv

If you want to treat yourself, need advice or have a question about your medication, visit your local pharmacist.

GP Surgery

If you have a medical problem that is not life-threatening visit your family doctor who can provide a range of services by appointment, including medical advice, examinations and prescriptions.

Out-of-hours doctor and dental services

If you have a medical problem but it is not life-threatening and can't wait until the next day or over the weekend you can access the out-of-hours GP and dentist services. Minor Injuries Unit

If your injury is not serious but can't wait until the next day or over the weekend, you can get help from the minor injuries unit.

Urgent Care Centre

If you have a minor injury or medical problem that is urgent but not life threatening, visit the urgent care centre.

Accident and Emergency (A&E)

999 Accident and Emergency (A&E) departments should only be used in a critical or life -threatening situation.

Appointments

We aspire to offer routine appointments with a doctor and nurse, but during busy periods this may not always be possible. Our receptionists will always do their best to accommodate your request, so please be understanding. Shingles vaccination

A vaccine to prevent shingles, a common, painful skin disease is now available on the NHS to anyone aged **70**, **78** or **79**.

The shingles vaccine is given as a single injection. Unlike the flu jab, you'll only need to have the vaccination once. The vaccine is expected to reduce your risk of getting shingles. If you are unlucky enough to go on to have the disease, your symptoms may be milder and the illness shorter.

Shingles can be very painful and uncomfortable. Some people are left with pain lasting for years after the initial rash has healed. And shingles is fatal for around 1 in 1,000 over-70s who develop it. It's fine to have the shingles vaccine if you've already had shingles. The shingles vaccine works very well in people who have had shingles before and it will boost your immunity against further shingles attacks.
